Who is Holly Etchegary? Dr. Holly Etchegary is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Medicine at Memorial University and the Academic lead for the provincial SPOR Support Unit. She is a social scientist and health services researcher with particular interest in the impact and management of inherited cancers and other genetic conditions. She regularly partners with patients in her research program.

What will Dr. Etchegary talk about? This short talk will provide a brief overview of the Strategy for Patient Oriented Research, providing context for partnering with patients and public engagement in cancer research.
