Who is Dr. Stuckless?

Dr. Teri Stuckless graduated from the Faculty of Medicine at Memorial University and completed residency training in radiation oncology at Queen's University, Kingston, Ontario.

She is the Clinical Chief of the provincial Cancer Care Program at Eastern Health and a Director in the Office of Learner Well-being and Success in the Faculty of Medicine, providing oversight for the career advising and mentorship programs for medical learners.

She has experience as the interim Vice President of Medicine for Eastern Health. She is a radiation oncologist at the Dr. H. Bliss Murphy Cancer Centre and Assistant Professor in the Discipline of Oncology at MUN.

Her areas of clinical practice include the management of gynecologic and gastrointestinal malignancies. Academic interests include cancer survivorship and sexual health, human resource management and well-being.

Who is Dr. Savas?

Dr. Sevtap Savas is a cancer researcher.

Originally from Turkiye, she has made Newfoundland and Labrador home since 2008.

She is currently a professor at the Division of Biomedical Sciences, with a cross-appointment to Discipline of Oncology, at Memorial University. She is also a member of the Atlantic Cancer Consortium, senior scientist at BHCRI, board member and the chair of the Advocacy Committee of the Canadian Association of Psychosocial Oncology.

Her goal is to improve the conditions and survival experiences of cancer patients and families.

For this purpose, she does research in the lab, data analyses using computers, partner with patient and family members, and serve in local and national committees that have similar goals.

She leads the Public Interest Group on Cancer Research. She is the lead organizer of the Public Conference on Cancer.
